**Germ Busting!** 'Tis the season for sharing germs! Some viruses and bacteria can live over 2 hours on tables, doorknobs, and shopping cart handles. Here are some tips to help keep the community healthy this season. Wash your hands frequently with soap and warm water. Hand sanitizer works well, too. The five key times to wash hands are: Before eating, after sneezing or coughing, after playing outdoors, after playing with pets, and after using the bathroom. In addition, anytime you see dirt, use soap and water to cleanse away the germs and grime. Cover your mouth when coughing or sneezing: use a tissue or your elbow rather than your hands. The number one germ buster is hand washing-get in the habit with the whole family.
